In 2015, Brigadier General Alicia A. Tate-Nadeau received her promotion from Colonel to Brigadier General, adding to an impressive resume and thereby becoming the first female in the Illinois National Guard to earn the rank.

Brigadier General Tate-Nadeau currently serves as the Assistant Adjutant General/Director of the Joint Staff, Illinois National Guard. A native of Enid, Oklahoma, she graduated from the University of Central Oklahoma with a bachelor's degree in health and received a commission in the Army Reserve through the Reserve Officers' Training Corps in 1986. She later earned masters' degrees in health administration and strategic studies from Governors State University and the U.S. Army War College, respectively. BG Tate-Nadeau was certified in Homeland Security by the American Board for Certification in Homeland Security, credentialed as a Certified Emergency Manager<sup>®</sup> (CEM<sup>®</sup>) by the International Association of Emergency Managers, and received Executive Certification in Counter-Terrorism, International Institute for Counter-Terrorism from the Lauder School of Government in Herzliya, Israel.

## IN MEMORIAM

**Barry C. Cicero (1944 - 2015)** - U.S. Army veteran and longtime resident of Western Springs, passed away Friday October 2nd, 2015. A tireless positive campaigner for veterans, Barry worked as Veteran Liaison for the MBDO and as a MBDO Director-At-Large.

In addition, Mr. Cicero enjoyed a lifelong relationship with the American Legion, culminating in his role as Past Commander, First Division, American Legion Dept. of Illinois. The MBDO Board salutes Barry's service and we are honored that he was part of our organization. We join his many friends and family in mourning his loss.

**Lennel Grace Jr. (1949 - 2016)** - Director Lennel Grace passed away unexpectedly on March 3, 2016. Born in Chicago, Illinois in 1949, Lennel grew up in Maywood, where he attended Garfield Elementary School and Proviso East High School. He also attended Triton College and Chicago State University.

A longtime community activist, Lennel was a member of the Illinois Prairie Path Association, Housing Helpers, the Maywood Historical Preservation Commission and the Neighbors of Maywood Community Organization (NoMCO), where he was serving as president at the time of his death.

Lennel was elected as a member of the Maywood Bataan Day Organization Board in 2011 and played an important role in the development of a relationship with The Home Depot Foundation.
