Command Sergeant Major Sean P. Carney is the State Command Sergeant Major for the Illinois Army National Guard, which consists of 10,000 citizen-Soldiers. He leads and mentors the noncommissioned officer corps and is responsible for all areas influencing enlisted members including training, discipline, morale and well-being.

CSM Carney enlisted in the Army in 1987 as a Cavalry Scout. He attended basic training at Fort Knox, Kentucky. CSM Carney has deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom II from 2003 to 2005 and again with the 33rd Infantry Brigade Combat Team as part of Combined Joint Task Force Phoenix VIII in 2008 to 2009. CSM Carney served as both Camp Phoenix garrison command sergeant major and the 634th Logistics Task Force command sergeant major. He has been a Command Sergeant Major since 2007.

566th Air Force National Guard Band of the Midwest

Under the direction of Lt. Col. Bryan M. Miller, the Air National Guard Band of the Midwest will make its first appearance at a Maywood Bataan Day Memorial Service on Sunday, September 8, 2019 with a concert at 2:30 PM and the Memorial Service at 3:00 PM.

He leads one of only five units in the Air National Guard bands program and is responsible for providing world-class musical products to enhance community relations and military support in a 10-state area of responsibility.

Lt. Col. Miller volunteered for Air Expeditionary Force deployments in 2010 and 2012, leading U.S. Air Forces Central Command band missions in numerous undisclosed locations throughout Southwest Asia and Africa. He also has led stateside performance missions at Mount Rushmore's Independence Day celebration, Rockefeller Center Plaza's "Centennial of Flight", memorial honors for President Ronald Reagan, ceremonies honoring Neil Armstrong, the Tuskegee Airmen and Illinois gubernatorial inaugurations. Lt. Col. Miller has also provided manning assistance to several active duty Air Force bands, has guest-conducted the U.S. Air Force Band and has produced recording sessions for the USAF Band of Mid-America at Chicago's Symphony Center.

A traditional Guardsman, Lt. Col. Miller is a career music educator in his civilian capacity. He has served as a high school music department chair since 1994 and has also concurrently served on the music education faculty for multiple colleges. He was one of 10 music teachers chosen to serve on the National Association for Music Education's National Council of Music Program Leaders. He is the founder of the Chicagoland Educators Orchestra and serves on the Chicago Youth Symphony Orchestra's board of directors, as well as presenter, conductor or clinician for various organizations.
